Your host will reach out to you on where and when to meet up. Typically, this is in the host's business office. During this time, you will see different job opportunities highlighting the diverse careers available, in addition to the field work. There will be lunch provided and there will be a ride-a-long to a site visit(s). Remember to bring your personal protective gear, clothing, and water with you on the site visit(s).

All attendees need to come equipped with close toe shoes - boots are ideal. Job sites can get mucky; please wear shoes you are okay with getting dirty.

7:15 AM	PPE distributed to educator attendees. Head to job site #1 & attend safety meeting. All additional job site hazards and safety considerations discussed. Quick overview of activities/jobs easily visible on site.
8:00 AM	Job trailer orientation. Review of careers/jobs completed in job trailer; overview of reading job plans, elevations, material calculations, technology in bidding and planning for projects.
9:30 AM	Equip with proper PPE, head to job site and 'shadow' grade checker. Discuss grade checker duties, material calculations, & technology necessary. Discussion: pathway for career as a grade checker, math skills needed.
10:30 AM	Head back to job site trailer and debrief - additional discussion regarding grade checkers, calculations, reading plans discussion, and open Q & A session.
11:00 AM	Tour manufacturing facility.
12:00 PM	Lunch & general discussion on education and construction.
1:00 PM	Job site #2 tour: Address
2:00 PM	Observe & shadow grade checker - discussion on how differs from other job site.
3:00 PM	Return to first job site, quick debrief, close experience.
